- Olive Wahoush: large group PBL prep for Fall 2015- great response to the online blog and clinical
 - Good feedback posted, and this is taken into consideration
 - Hoping to have a final plan by march hopefully for the PBL 40 groups
 - The program is advertising groups of 8-40 for the upcoming first years now (breakout groups included for activities)
 - How the evaluations with these larger groups will run will need to be changed
 - Looking at various resources to see how the evaluations (self, peer and tutor)
 will work with larger groups
 - Research practicum required for all students and option for elective in leadership management- faculty wondering in changing electives to make some mandatory
 - There have been cases where students unable to graduate on time due to clinical placements
 - Conestoga will have a meeting next week, looking at simulation and clinical placements (for NCLEX preparation where students don't get the pediatrics or OB placements, but those are testable on the NCLEX)
 - Ministry, RNAO, CNO will be in attendance at this meeting
 - Research says that placement time can be replaced by simulation time to facilitate better learning
 - Let faculty know of what can be adjusted, changed in curriculum to help success in the NCLEX exam in the end
- New initiative- try to revamp the school of nursing website within the next 4-6 weeks
 - MUNSS videos
 - PBL videos
 - Student testimonials
- Faculty of health sciences wanted graduate nursing students to make where they are now videos
 - Some of their success influenced by specifically the program
 - 4 students identified and they are doing various successful paths currently
 - All chose different paths and different locations
- Need more transparency between feedback- how can students know that the feedback they provide is getting taken into consideration
 - Best thing is to Cc Carolyn Byrne or Olive Wahoush into follow-up emails
- Mental health initiative- having a whole week dedicated to mental health awareness and support to other students
 - Partner with St.Joe's (mountain site) and have 2 key note speakers to close off the week
 - Promote mental health awareness
 - Something around the stigma around mental health
 - Possibly hold a ThinkTank, inviting other faculties and partners at St.Joe's regarding this topic
 - Should also partner with Student Wellness because they run initiatives around this topic to respond to student mental health and wellness along with various

- faculties
- CNSA will try to get time on the agenda at either regional or national conference to see what other universities are doing around this topic
- Maybe try and do around the same time as Bell Let's Talk
- o Next steps: contact partners, set up a ThinkTank, start contacting various people
- Someone from schizophrenia association of Ontario willing to run a mental health first aid workshop- she is willing to work around the time
- Cassy anti-stigma initiative being run at Conestoga with nursing faculty (Jane Hamilton)
 - Accessible through myConestoga
- RPN clinical-simulation lab shifts was helpful as you were able to practice more skills in the simulation lab, it was a safe environment
 - Able to interact with 2 different groups
 - Everyone will be on the same place regardless of clinical placements because not everyone can do all the skills in the hospital placements
- \$10,000 surplus application 2 people have currently sent in the application
 - How to benefit students with this extra money
 - We must spend this money as it is coming from students in school this year
 - WW swag, mental health first aid workshop are the 2 applications that have come forth
