    - MUNSS is considering putting forth a bid to host nursing games next year.
      - Good campus to host nursing games- athletic facility close together to other facilities so it limits travelling
      - Spread awareness of event to Mac students since not many know about the event itself
      - Would be nice to showcase other campuses such as Conestoga which has an awesome lab area
      - Would need to get solid amount of people who would be willing to coordinate the event (around 5-6 people)
  - Dodgeball, floor hockey and soccer are the 3 sporting events this year
  - Includes 3 sports, keynote speaker, social events, academic simulation challenges
  - $\circ~$  A compilation video showcasing the event would be great in advertising
    - Western has a video because they take the event seriously... use it to advertise perhaps because of the rivalry between Mac vs. Western
  - Need information of where fundraising and budget comes from to consider
  - UofT got \$5000 from their school of nursing... This may not be something the School of Nursing can support us with at this time.
    - UofT has a lot more money because they get more money from the government (no basic stream, it is second entry nursing) and more graduate nursing students tuition fees wise
  - Partner with CNSA and see how much money both can get money from Caroline Byrne

    - How would a patient feel if you, the nurse, are taking care of them and have a cast on yourself- how about infection control?
- 6 CNSA awards (\$1156) for national conference- usually 1 per school (4 members)

  - Only 15 chapter schools as of now
  - o Must be submitted by November 25<sup>th</sup>
