CNSA Division Proposal

- o proposal to have 3 OD's next year (1 for each site)
- more of an equal voice at both regional and national conferences, especially nationals where more voting occurs
- we are the second largest nursing school and yet have the same voice as a nursing school who has only 27 nursing students
- they would all still be a part of MUNSS, but having 3 voices nationwide would be beneficial in having changes done for our school
- the changes that occur at national conference will be evident in the CNSA role at our school specifically → EX. Last year's CNSA OD position statement on accessibility placements for clinical is being worked on at the

- university, they have contacted the Aboriginal campus which is a big position statement at last year's national conference
- MUNSS will cover cost of transportation, accommodations, conference fees for the CNSA OD and authors of proposed researchers as long as it is financially feasible for MUNSS; AD will be provided accommodation if they abide by the rules of Article 3 section 10 subsection c (solicit funds by fundraising to supplement conference expenses to the amount of at least \$250 in order to receive supplemental funding from the MUNSS executive budget)
- CNSA Constitutional revisions will be reviewed by the Core Executive
- would like to increase the RPN student involvement in the CNSA nationwide
- Motion: To have 3 OD's (1 at each site) for CNSA → closed vote-PASSED

- Article V Social Chair: in point (b) change monthly core meeting to "at the invitation of the core executive", in point © change to 1 social event each month, in point (g) change to quarterly reports, in point (h) change to plan at least one Frost Week event in collaboration with the WW planners,
