- Welcome Week 2015 Budget Review
 - \$15,000 donation given from MUNSS
 - \$2941 given from SSC
 - \$2714.71 grant for bussing, extra activities
 - hoping to fully subsidize swag next year as we are the only faculty that asks for swag money
 - go with a Canadian company instead of American for patches as the dollar is not doing well so we went over budget in this area
 - suggestions for WW 2016: possibility of allotting money to get Conestoga to the concert
- Constitution Review
 - Article II Purpose: McMaster University, Mohawk College and Conestoga College, instead of only McMaster University
 - Article IV Executive Officers: change secretary → executive assistant, add “one per site” to education chairpersons, take out “one from the McMaster site” for WW planner, add Global Understanding Through Nursing Initiatives (GUNI) liaison as an executive officer position
 - Article IV Executive Officers, point 2: add that executive officers must be a McMaster-Mohawk-Conestoga B.Sc.N student unless appointed by the executive, in point (b) take out Executive Assistant and Uniforms out so that they have a vote as well and add in WW planners as they don’t have a vote, in point (d) edit to “check @munss.ca email a minimum of once weekly and respond in a professional manner within a 72 hour time period upon viewing the email”
 - Article IV Executive Officers, point 4: add CNSA OD as a core member
 - Article V President: in point (c) edit to “approve the agenda to the executive assistant at least 2 days prior to each executive meeting”, remove point (f) and allocate it to the Vice Presidents, in point (h) edit to “have at least 1 year of MUNSS executive experience the prior year with a

- recommended of 2 years of MUNSS executive experience”, remove point (j), remove point (k) and move to communications
- Article V Vice Presidents: in point (d) take out MUNSS Day being 2 weeks before Nursing Formal, in point (f) edit it to “coordinate Anatomy and Physiology Exam gift during December exam period”, in point (g) edit to “be responsible for distributing and obtaining quarterly reports from Executive members and notifying the president if there is an immediate concern at the following core meeting”, remove point (h), add “pursue an open relationship with Conestoga Students Inc. (CSI), McMaster Student Union (MSU) and the Mohawk Students Association (MSA)”
 - Article V Deputy Vice President: remove point (e)
 - Article V Executive Assistant: in point (b) remove “society events”, in point (d) edit to “distribute the agenda and any attached communications, as submitted by the President, to the Core and Executive at least one (1) day prior to Executive meetings on @munss.ca webmail, remove point (f), in point (g) edit to “submit minutes to Communication Chairperson for distribution to the nursing student body via the MUNSS website, change point (l) to be a voting member
 - Article V Communications Chairperson: in point (g) edit to “quarterly updates”
